**Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting Vehicle
Fluorine-Free Foam (F3) Transition Services**

Date: July 23, 2026

The contents of this addendum are in addition to the technical approach listed in the request for proposals (RFP) issued on July 8, 2026 for aircraft rescue and firefighting (ARFF) vehicle fluorine-free foam (F3) transition services at the Manistee County Blacker Airport (MBL). The RFP can be found on the MBL website at: <https://www.flymanistee.com/>. These items are not required to be met; however, they are being provided for consideration in the preparation of proposals.

1. *Do you have additional floor stock of AFFF that needs to be disposed of and included in the bid?* **There is one (1) 5-gallon pail of Chemguard 3% Aqueous Film-Forming Foam (AFFF); however, since a grant provided by the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) is funding this activity, disposal of stockpile AFFF is not eligible. Coordination with MBL outside the scope of activities listed in the RFP for F3 transition services would be necessary for disposal.**
2. *What type of handlines are currently on the truck? Booster reel? Woven attack lines?* **There is a reeled handline on the rear of the truck that discharges both foam and entrained dry chemical. Also, there is a cavity for a woven handline that does not have a hose stored or connected.**
3. *Number of handlines? [on the ARFF vehicle]* **Two (2).**
4. *If a temporary vehicle of the one similar you have is not available, are you open to at least a 1500 gallon ARFF truck?* **Yes.**
